

Greece Areas' Free Ambulance Service to Open

Volunteers will start free round-the-clock emergency ambulance service in the Greece-Ridge and North Greece fire districts at 8 a. m. tomorrow.

The ambulance was purchased with donations of residents of the areas. More than 125 people have been trained in first aid and ambulance work and will take turns standing by.

The ambulance is housed temporarily in the town sewage treatment plant, 1100 Latta Rd., while officers of the Greece Volunteer Ambulance Service Inc. seek permanent quarters.

The ambulance telephone number is CH 2-5800.

When the new company starts operation tomorrow it will bring ambulance service to the remaining Greece areas that now do not have such service. Ambulance service is provided in other areas of the town by fire companies in the Barnard and Lake Shore fire districts (Barnard and Grand View Heights firemen).
