

Ambulance Drive Raises \$8,200

Ground is expected to be broken this week for the start of construction of new headquarters for Greece Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc., at Long Pond Road and English Road.

The building will house the organization's ambulance, which has served the western section of the town since January 1, handling more than 170 calls.

A three-week fund canvass, contributions totaling more than 100 volunteer workers, closed Monday night with contribution totaling \$8,200, according to Frederick J. Conway, chairman of the

drive. Part of the money will be used for maintenance of the ambulance and the balance for payment on the property.

Fred E. Strauss, president of Greece Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc., voiced thanks this week to all residents who contributed during the campaign. Their support, he said, has assured continued service.

The ambulance has been housed temporarily at the town treatment plant in Latta Road. The new quarters in Long Pond Road will be in the heart of the area the ambulance serves.
